After graduation, our students proceed to become:

Why study with us:

- 1. Course duration is 5 class semesters and 3 months industrial attachment. Total cost of tuition is Ksh 270,500
- 2. The total amount of scholarship for the first 50 students is Ksh 189,350 for the entire course duration which translates to Ksh 37,870 per semester
- 3. Total cost of tuition payable by student is Ksh 81,150 for the entire course duration translating to Ksh 16,230 per semester
- 4. Accommodation is available on campus as part of the fees
- 5. Organic food available on campus and is covered in the fees
- 6. Games, clubs, and academic tours available
- 7. Exchange programs with other institutions and organizations in and outside Kenya
- 8. Assured field attachment in SACDEP's development projects and other development agencies in and outside Kenya
